WHAT IS CLOUD ACCOUNTING?

The main difference between cloud and desktop packages is that, instead of installing the software on your computer, cloud packages run on remote, secure servers which are accessed using the internet.

Data is securely stored on these servers, known as 'the cloud'. Using the cloud gives you instant access to real time information regarding your accounts which can be accessed and worked on from any location in the world with an internet connection, via any device, be it PC, Mac or mobile. All that is required is a working internet connection.
